# Museum officially opens new doors

After leaving its original home in the basement of McArthur Place, the Lac La Biche County Museum and Visitor Centre is now officially open at Jubilee Hall.

The occasion was celebrated by the County and museum faithful last Thursday with a ceremonial ribbon cutting and speeches from guests like mayor Omer Moghrabi and MP David Yurdiga.

The museum had been moved to Jubilee Hall a few months back, but the ceremony celebrated its official opening and the placement of an exterior sign.

The move from the basement has been an overall positive experience according to museum director Jennifer Mueller.

"We're really happy here. It was definitely a major undertaking to be able to move everything safely, and set everything up in quite a short amount of time. I would say that now we're just very excited to move forward." she said.

"It's given us a lot more space. We're able to get more items from our collections out for people to see, which is really nice. Also, with being on Main Street, it's more visible for the public," she said.

One of the newer features to the museum and visitor centre is new signage.

The museum is operated with municipal funding as well as funds from provincial and federal sources.

"It was really nice to be able to have our signage out on the street and then also over our door. It's some beautiful signage provided by the county," she said. "The renovations for this building were partially sponsored by the Lac La Biche County, so really, it's their generosity along with the generosity of Canadian Heritage that made it possible."

The new location has already helped the museum and visitor centre attract more guests.

"In June, for instance, we probably saw double the amount of people that we had from last year," said Mueller.

The move has also come with an increase in local donations with residents donating the long-lost treasures of their attics and basements.

"People from the community are coming forward with some different items ... More people from the community are appreciating their history," said Mueller. "We have such an interesting history here in Lac La Biche County, they want to kind of contribute to that by giving us donated items."

Museum staff and their operating board are already making plans for the future, with new exhibits to utilize their extra space.

"We have plans to do a special archery exhibit, then ... once we hit October, there'll be a Halloween exhibit and and then also there's going to be a Christmas exhibit."

Mueller invitedresidents to come see the museum and many of the new and retooled exhibits.

"Come out and see, we've got so many new exhibits. A number of our other exhibits that we had at McArthur Place have been retooled, kind of changed up a bit — so there's a lot of new things for people to see," she said. "Also, with us changing over temporary exhibits here in the new future there's always going to be something new to see."
